These presentations are to provide useful strategies in working with children who exhibit challenging behaviors. Discussion about functional relations and behaviorally based strategies will be explored with a focus on teaching functionally equivalent replacement behaviors. Whether we are supporting a child with ADHD, ODD or Autism Spectrum Disorder, these methods have been empirically validated over 60 years and are quite different from traditional psychological approaches. The interventions we utilize should be individualized to the unique needs of each child and aim to be as practical and meaningful as possible. Following discussion, parents will be provided an opportunity to ask questions.
