Lanesborough and Williamstown have a long history of educational collaboration. The two towns have shared a middle/high school since 1961. The elementary schools joined together in 2008 to form Superintendency Union 71. In 2010, SU71 and Mount Greylock entered into a shared services agreement and most recently, the two towns voted overwhelmingly to fully regionalize effective July 1, 2018.

Lanesborough & Williamstown have a combined population of 11,000 residents. Total enrollment in the District is approximately 1200 students.

We are located in the northwestern corner of Massachusetts in the beautiful Berkshires. Our students and staff have access to tremendous local resources, from institutions of higher learning (MCLA, Williams College) to several world class museums (The Clark, Mass MOCA, Williams College Museum of Art), cultural opportunities (Shakespeare & Co., Williamstown Theatre Festival, Hancock Shaker Village) and outdoor educational opportunities.

Lanesborough Elementary School (LES) is a pre-K to grade 6 elementary school with approximately 200 students. The Principal is Nolan Pratt.
